An Audiologist position is available at Hornsby Ku-ring-gai Health Service in the leafy northern suburbs of Sydney's North Shore. Our Audiology service is well-established in our local community with a reputation for managing patients of all ages and abilities. At the present time, our caseload is primarily outpatient, from age 7 months through adulthood. Our philosophy is that it is extremely cost effective at all ages to manage hearing difficulties early and well, so there is a strong emphasis at each assessment in informing our clients, many of whom will be attending our Unit only once.

There could be opportunities for extending this educational aspect. For example, for anyone interested in such a role, developing skills and awareness in our hospital staff regarding better management of hearing loss in our older in-patients would be a very valuable project. We have the tools and the expertise to help with such a project.

Applicants must be, or be eligible to be, a full member of the Audiological Society of Australia, and to be eligible to hold the Society's Certificate of Clinical Practice. Significant clinical experience with patients of all ages and abilities, and experience in a hospital setting, is desirable. Salary according to NSW Audiologists employed in Public Hospitals Determination.

The position is fulltime but is open to part-time job-share possibilities if required.
